

HEALTH & SAFETY REPRESENTATIVES

What the Law Says: When there are 20 or more employees, for every group of up to 50 people in the workplace, (or in the case of a shop or an office for every group of up to 100 people), at least one Health and Safety Representative must be designated in writing. (Extracted from the Occupational Health and Safety Act - Section 17)

It is the general duty of the employer to their employees to provide information, instructions, training and supervision as necessary to ensure the health and safety at work. (Extracted from the Occupational Health and Safety Act - Section 8)

Our HSE Rep course will provide more than just a certificate. Students will leave with a clear understanding of their responsibilities and confidence to implement what they have learnt enabling them to effect the change needed to better promote safety and compliance.
