

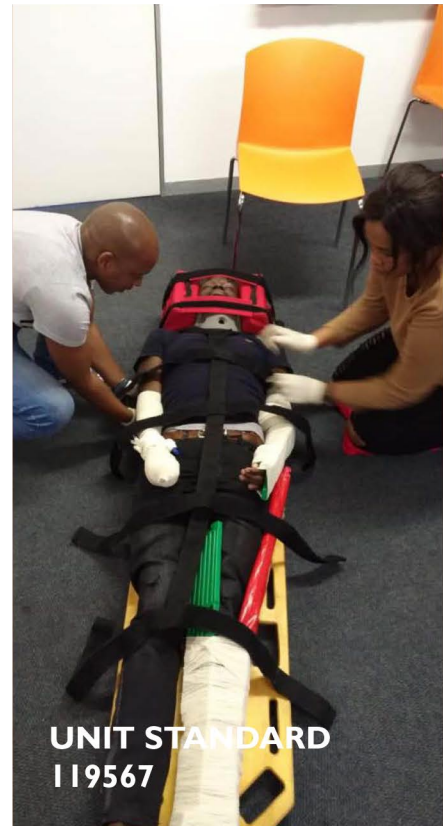
FIRST AID LEVEL I
